Hat's off to David, who finished his stay with us this month!









Unusual root growth. Pizotes digging up a corn patch, possibly looking for jobotos, which potentially caused the loss of several scallion roots that we had replanted. And interesting nests of cuiscana, fire ants and their eggs!





Big bamboo harvest during the ebbing moon phase. Hopefully this will help the bamboo last longer. We're still observing some minimal bat damage on our ripe bananas.
